Dear Hamasdegh Parent,

Last Sunday Hamasdegh students in 6th, 7th and 8th grades and 2019 graduates enjoyed a day of sightseeing the Nation's Capital's most important Armenian sites. They visited the Armenian Embassy where they met with Marianna Manucharyan and Gohar Hovsepyan who spoke about the rigorous program of becoming an Armenian diplomat. Most importantly, students, teachers and parents were made to feel valued and warmly welcomed in "their home." Next stop was the beautiful Armenian Mother statue at the National Headquarters of the American Red Cross. This statue was built by Frederic Sogoyan and gifted in 1991 to thank the American Red Cross for their life saving efforts after the devastating earthquake of 1988. The last stop on the field trip was the ANCA office where students learned about the recent bill that passed the House affirming the Armenian Genocide. Many students had questions about the next steps in getting the bill to the President. Aram Hamparian spoke about reparations and the kids were interested in learning more about the positive repercussions of the US Congress recognizing the Genocide.

Hamasdegh PTA would like to thank the Embassy of Armenia and ANCA for their warm hospitality, as well as all teachers and parents who chaperoned students on this inaugural field trip. We look forward to making this an annual event.


