The Hamasdegh PTA wishes you and your loved ones a blessed and Happy Thanksgiving!

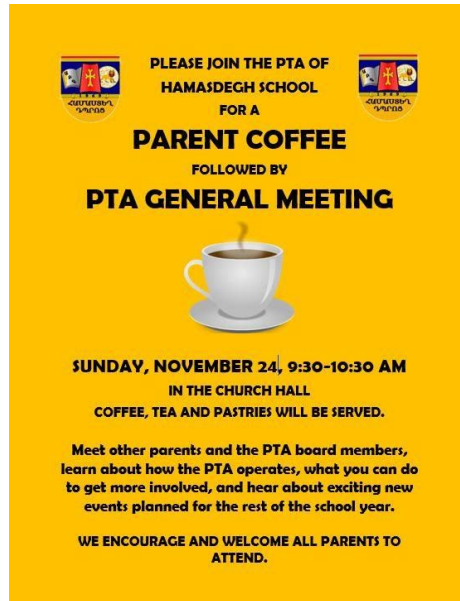
