Much awaited Grades 6-8 Field Trip is finally here! Our inaugural Armenian DC Field Trip will take place this Sunday, November 10, during school hours. Children will leave for the field trip promptly at 10am, with the first stop at the Embassy of Armenia where they will tour the building and meet with Embassy staff. Then they will visit the American Red Cross statue donated by Armenia as a gift of gratitude for aid received after the 1988 earthquake, and finally the ANCA office where they will meet Yeghisapet Chouldjian to discuss the work of Hai Tad office and enjoy lunch. Lunch is included so no need to pack lunch. Only children with submitted permission slips will be permitted to attend the field trip. Please fill out and submit the electronic permission slip by tomorrow, Friday, November 8, noon (even if you don't plan on sending your child on the field trip, please fill out the form to let us know they will not attend). Given the historic vote this past week, this is a field trip not to be missed!
